(formerly known as Ouch Pricing Feed)

1. Overview

The Nasdaq BX (BX) MatchView Feed (formerly known as Ouch Pricing Feed) is a real-time BX Market data feed that provides a view into what the Nasdaq BX execution system sees as the prevailing Best Bid and Offer of the other exchanges. This feed works in conjunction with OUCH, and is used to prevent trade-throughs and quote-throughs from occurring.

Type	8	1	Alpha	"U"	The message type. For this feed, the only value will be "U"

Bid Price	17	10	Numeric	12870000	The price on the bid with 6 whole number places followed by 4 decimal digits. The decimal point is implied by position; it does not appear inside the price field. The price is padded with spaces on the left.
Ask Price	27	10	Numeric	1234870000	The price on the ask with 6 whole number places followed by 4 decimal digits. The decimal point is implied by position; it does not appear inside the price field. The price is padded with spaces on the left.
