Cardiac Control Systems, Inc. - Common Stock (CDCS)
Renaissance Acceptance Group, Inc. - Common Stock (RNAG)

Notice has been received that the above Company's (Cardiac) Plan of Reorganization (Plan) filed under Chapter XI of the Federal Bankruptcy Code, became effective on July 2, 2001. Pursuant to the Plan, holders of Cardiac *will not* receive any distributions of property on account of their interests.

To effect the reorganization, Cardiac merged with Remodelers Holdings, Inc. (RHI). The resulting entity changed its name to Renaissance Acceptance Group, Inc. (Renaissance or RNAG) and shares of RNAG will only be issued to a liquidating trust and to certain creditors and shareholders of Cardiac and not to all public shareholders. *Members are advised that the shares of Cardiac which were outstanding prior to the reorganization did not change their name to Renaissance and positions in CDCS will not automatically be converted to shares of RNAG.* Therefore, members are further advised to investigate their internal systems to properly reflect positions in CDCS and RNAG.

Members are reminded of their obligations under NASD Conduct Rule 2310 if they continue to engage in transactions in the above security after the effective date.

Members are further advised that deliveries in settlement of contracts in the <u>OLD</u> securities, which were executed prior to the announcement that the securities had been deemed worthless, shall be evidenced by either a) the <u>OLD</u> security; or b) a *Letter of Indemnity* which shall grant the purchaser any rights and privileges which might accrue to the holders of the physical securities. Such deliveries shall operate to close-out the contract and shall be settled at the existing contract price pursuant to Uniform Practice Code Rule 11530.
